HUMAN RIGHTS DAY POSTER COMPETITION

Application Form and Guidelines

The Human Rights Committee of District 16 T/OT annually hosts the Human Rights Day Poster Competition. Eligible students must be a YRDSB student in grades 9-12. One award, valued at \$300 will be given to the artist of the winning poster. Each applicant must have the name of a supporting OSSTF member to assist them with their submission.

Criteria for the poster:

A completed application form

A visual poster, sent to the OSSTF D16 T/OT Human Rights Committee, that includes the following:

- Must be an original piece
- Poster can be in any visual medium (*paint, pencil, mixed media, graphic design, charcoal, etc*)
- Size must be 8.5"x14" or 11" x 17"
- Must include the following information on the poster:
 - 'Human Rights Day" (noticable title)
 - December 10th (no year)
 - No other writing on the poster aside from the title and the day.
- The applicant may be asked to provide evidence that the artwork is an original piece.

Deadline:

All completed application packages must be received by the Human Rights Committee Chair at the D16T/OT office by March 31st each year. Applications will all be submitted electronically via Google Forms.

Award:

One prize of \$300 will be awarded to the artist of the winning poster as decided by the Human Rights Committee. Winner will be notified and a picture of the poster will be posted to the D16 T/OT website by the end of April.
